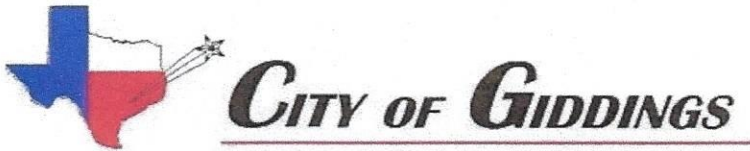

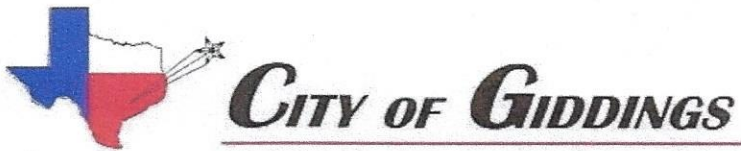

CenterPoint is seeking recovery of \$7,723,694. The current filing will increase rates to residential customers by \$3.72 per month. This will increase the current residential customer charge from \$27.03 to \$30.75 per month. The increase is currently scheduled to go into effect on May 1, 2023. This resolution will suspend the effective date to increase by 45 days.


