# I. Call to Order

#### V. Consent Agenda

#### VI. New Business

- a) Rashay K. Chapa with Linebarger Goggan Blair & Sampson, LLP Attorney at Law presented and answered questions regarding tax suit and tax sale process. Not an action item.
- b) Ordinance 718 was tabled. Council would like to have additional wording to include privacy law for those purchasing or selling items electronically.
- c) Council Member Alan Casey moved to approve Ordinance 719 to raise the water rates for commercial and residential. (\$0.30 per 1000/gal.)

Motion failed due to lack of a second.

d) Council Member Linda Pruitt moved to approve the Police Department to purchase 1 radar unit and the video server for the amount of \$4,460.40. The motion was seconded by Council Member Joel Lopez.

Ordinance 720 amending the 2014-2015 budget was not needed since the Police Department has recently completed its property room inventory/purge, resulting in \$4,460.40 of unexpected funds being deposited to the City's General Fund.
